This means that we work as a **team** to provide your healthcare. You, as the patient, are an integral facet of our partnership as we work to deliver you the best care possible.

As a patient centered medical home, we will help **coordinate** appointments, testing and procedures for you. We will communicate with specialists we refer you to and ensure that your transition of care is secured.

What is your role?

- Call 911 for all emergencies!
- Call Valley Diagnostic Medical Center first with any questions and/or concerns.
- Schedule regular office visits, screenings and follow-up visits.
- Be familiar with your insurance benefits, need for referrals and any restrictions/limitations.
- If you send messages through the patient portal, be aware that portal messages are monitored during
 office hours. Messages sent after hours will be addressed the next business day.
- Our physicians admit to Valley Hospital and we continue to see our own patients during their hospital stay. We will also contact you after your discharge to check on you and to schedule a follow-up appointment.
- If you see a specialist or had services done in another facility/hospital, please have the consult notes/labs and test results forwarded to our office so your chart is always updated.
